against Phylip Babayan and Arthur Ohanezian in Police Department of Dzveli Tbilisi.

As reported, only Philip Babayan and Arthur Oganezian were charged on the case, while policemen were granted victim status, which raises doubts about conduct of investigation in a biased and subjective manner.

Failure of the state to investigate foregoing facts effectively and impartially will undermine public trust to the key state institutions and will question state policy in terms of combating torture and ill-treatment.

Georgian Young Lawyers Association calls on the General Prosecutor Office of Georgia to ensure comprehensive, effective and impartial investigation on the case and to study alleged hate motive under the ethnic ground in the commied offence.
