Tamar Zhvania - CEC chairperson and Ana Natsvlishvili [\[www.gyula.ge\]](#) GYLA chairperson signed the Memorandum.

Promotion of public awareness and election culture are supposed to be the cornerstone for development of democratic election process. Organizations are eager to contribute to civil engagement, increase of voters [\[www.gyula.ge\]](#) awareness and popularization of elections among population at large, especially in youth, vulnerable and minority groups. For achieving stated objectives, the parties will cooperate closely in the framework of successful implementation of [\[www.gyula.ge\]](#) Development Schools 2015 A project.

In the period of July 13-24, 2015 17-25 years old youth will have an opportunity to undergo the training course in 10 election districts and to obtain necessary knowledge on election issue that will assist to improvement of democratic process in the country.
